Theological Reflection Case Consultation Group Participant Policies & Guidelines

GROUP FORMAT

The Group will meet 1 ½ hours twice per month on the 2nd & 4th Fridays at 1PM. The group will meet at The Counseling Center at Belle Meade United Methodist church located at 121 Davidson Road, Nashville, TN 37205. The group will involve required reading to help create a common vocabulary for theological reflection. Most of the meetings will involve group participants sharing case material from their own clinical work for group reflection. Participants will be encouraged to reflect personally on their own traditions and challenges in the case material presented. The group will, therefore, require personal sharing. Due to the nature of the case material and personal sharing, participants must be able to be respectful with other group members and with the case material.

ATTENDANCE & FEES

- Group participants agree to attend and pay for all group sessions unless other arrangements are made before the group begins.
- For unforeseen reasons, there may be a reason that group cannot meet. We will make every effort to reschedule such sessions. Group participants will not be responsible for paying for sessions if the group does not meet and the session cannot be rescheduled at a reasonable time.
- Unless other arrangements have been made, payments are to be made at each session.
- As long as group members are part of the group, members will be responsible for paying for sessions whether they attend group or not (emergencies, illness, excepted at the facilitator's discretion).
- Payment for sessions may be made by cash, check (made payable to "Counseling Center at BMUMC"), credit cards, mobile pay apps including Venmo, Apple Pay, Android Pay, & Samsung Pay.
- No CEUs will be granted for this group. Participants desiring CEUs are encouraged to participate in the January 26th Workshop at the center. (Request more information if interested).

CONFIDENTIALITY

To maximize the usefulness of this consultation group, confidentiality of case material presented and personal sharing of group members is of utmost importance. Group members will be given a general format for preparing case material presented to the group. In all case presentations, group members should seek to protect all potentially identifying information about clients presented. In the rare case that a client being presented is recognized by another group member, that group member may be excused from the conversation for the day.
